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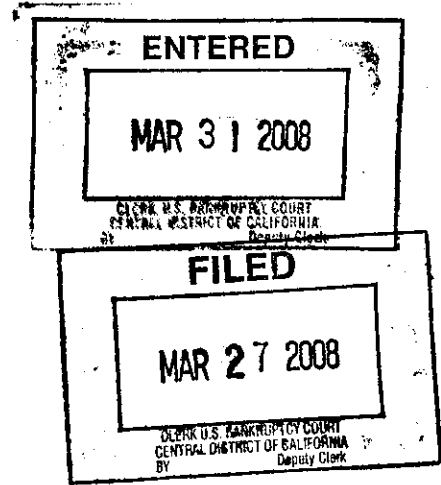

1 The "Debtor's Emergency Motion For Order Authorizing Debtor To Maintain
2 Certain Active Bank Accounts, Cash Management System And Continue Use of its
3 Existing Business Forms" (the "Motion"), filed by eStyle, Inc. (the "Debtor"), debtor and
4 debtor in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 case, on March 19, 2008, came
5 on for initial hearing before the Court on March 21, 2008, and for continued hearing
6 before the Court on March 25, 2008. Appearances at the hearing are reflected in the
7 record.

8 Having considered the Motion, the Omnibus Declaration of Robert S.
9 Kelleher in Support of Debtor's "First-Day" Motions, the representations of counsel made
10 at the hearings, the facts and circumstances of this matter, and good cause appearing
11 therefor,

12 **IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

13 1. The Motion is granted, subject to the Debtor's agreement to discuss
14 continued use of its prepetition bank accounts with the Office of the United States
15 Trustee ("OUST") and the Debtor's agreement with the OUST that this Order shall be
16 effective through April 16, 2008.

17 2. In the event that the Debtor and the OUST do not reach an
18 agreement prior to April 16, 2008, regarding the Debtor's use of bank accounts, the
19 Motion is set for continued hearing on April 16, 2008, at 10:00 a.m.

20 3. The Debtor is authorized to maintain and continue to use prepetition
21 bank accounts with Wachovia Bank ("Wachovia") (account nos. 2000035271954,
22 2000035271967, 2000035271970, 2079900560608, and 2000036887897), Bank of
23 America (account no. 1459442762), and Wells Fargo Bank (account no. 2244026064)
24 (collectively the "Debtor's Accounts") and its prepetition cash management system (with
25 the limited modifications set forth below in paragraph no. 3) and to continue to use its
26 existing business forms, as requested in the Motion.

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
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4. Wachovia Bank and Wachovia Finance Capital Corporation

the Debtor's bank accounts and/or transferring in any manner any funds therein.


